Arrival at:

HOTEL RISTORANTE CALINFERNO

If you wish, you can take part in a guided tour **from 2 p.m. to around 6 p.m.**, which takes you to the center of CISON di VALMARINO, Castelbrando and the FOLLINA Abbey (with its Romanesque cloister dating back to 1268).

The tour then continues along a panoramic road to VALDOBBIADENE with a stop in the enchanting landscape of OSTERIA SENZA OSTE.

Return to the hotel and free evening with the option of a special dinner at the Calinferno restaurant.

Friday 20/06/2025

Breakfast at the hotel and **DEPARTURE AT 9.00 a.m.** towards the historic center of TREVISO and parking in an area that will soon be determined.

From 10.00 a.m. guided walk through the streets of the historic center and along the waters that characterize the city, with the arms of the Botteniga river that comes from the walls to the north, divides into various canals and then flows into the Sile.

Dante mentions Treviso in his Paradise as: "Where the Sile and the Cagnan meet."

At the Dante bridge we meet the Cagnan delle Peschiere canal, walk towards Buranelli, discover characteristic views and old mill wheels, reach the walls and then descend towards Calmaggioro, meet the Fontana delle Tette, come out in Piazza dei Signori and reach the Loggia dei Cavalieri.

After this panoramic orientation tour, you will have free time **from 11.30 am to 12 noon** for lunch at cicchetti, trattorias and typical restaurants or for further exploration.

Leave the parking lot by 5 p.m. and return to the hotel individually, free evening, with the possibility of a special dinner at the Calinferno restaurant.

Saturday 21/06/2025

Breakfast at the hotel and **DEPARTURE AT 9.00 AM**, even for those who are only participating on Saturday and are asked to be on time.

As a group we will go to Piazzale Castelvechio and San Leonardo near the CONEGLIANO castle and follow this route in case someone separates from the group:

We enter the old medieval village through the Porta Ser Bele **(be careful! narrow and treacherous passage)**, which is located on the summit of the “Colle di Giano”, practically the first elevation that leads north from Venice up the plain to the Prealps and Dolomites. Due to its strategic position for controlling the area, it has been inhabited since the Palaeolithic Age and in the Middle Ages it was merely a castle on the top of a hill.

Conegliano was the first of the inland municipalities to surrender to the Republic of Venice in 1337. Conegliano was called “the beloved” and experienced a remarkable boom, including the construction of the Carrara Walls, which run along the slopes of the hill and encompass the historic center with its elegant, frescoed buildings from the 15th and 16th centuries.

After parking in formation for photos,

visit **at 10: 00 a.m.** visit the CITY MUSEUM in the SCHLOSSTURM (entrance ticket, reduced for groups of more than 10 people, **€2 per person**) and climb to the top of the tower, from where you can admire a 360° panorama that stretches from the Dolomites in the north to the Julian Alps in Slovenia in the east, to the lagoon of Venice in the south and to the Euganean Hills of Padua and the Berici Hills of Vicenza on the west side, as well as an extended view of the Prosecco hills of Conegliano Valdobbiadene, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

At 11 a.m. we walk down a pedestrian path for about 650 meters, in about 15 minutes along the old Carrara walls that take us to the historic center at the foot of the hill:

There you will reach the cathedral with its frescoed façade to visit the SALA dei BATTUTI (entrance ticket, reduced for groups of more than 10 people, **€2 per person**).

FROM 12 TO 1 p.m. free of charge in the center of Conegliano and BACK TO THE PARKING PLACE, recommended via the gentler route of the asphalt road with hairpin bends:

We recommend limiting yourself to an aperitif or a small snack of sandwiches or cicchetti, as the next stop offers us an excellent refreshment ...

1.00 P.M.: Departure in convoy, exit again through the narrow medieval gate (ATTENTION!) for a first panoramic route between the hills, past the village of Collalbrigo:

We reach the SOMMARIVA PALAZZO ROSSO winery <https://sommарiva-vini.it/>

at 1.30 p.m., where we are invited to visit the cellar, followed by a refreshing drink with local products and a wine tasting, first and foremost PROSECCO, of course, in all its variations, from the driest to the sweetest.

Of course, there is also the opportunity to purchase the wines tasted from our own production.

15.00 hrs Departure for a short excursion to the ancient PIEVE DI SAN PIETRO di FELETTO:

This small church, built in a wonderful panoramic position, is the mother church of the area and was built from a first Lombard church dating back to the year 1000. A helper will open it for us and help us admire the very special frescoes that characterize it, dating from between 1200 and 1400.

Before leaving, we can enjoy the view of the vineyards of one of the most beautiful and gentle valleys of these hills, shaped by the cultivation of vines.

We set off again at 4 pm to reach the MOLINETTO DELLA CRODA in just a few minutes:

One of the most symbolic places in the province of Treviso, built on the rock (Croda in the Venetian language) in a shady valley that can also offer us a little refreshment.

They finally take us to the COLVENDRA winery <https://www.colvendra.it/> where, in the shade of a canopy overlooking the valley towards the previously visited Pieve di San Pietro di Feletto, we find tables laid out with further refreshment and the tasting of their wines, which include PROSECCO as well as VERDISO, some excellent red wines and the characteristic PASSITO DI REFRONTOLO DOC, obtained from Marzemino grapes after drying.

It is also possible to purchase bottles of our jointly tasted beverages.

From here, the return to the hotel is free and we meet again **at 8.00 pm for the GALA DINNER** in the CALINFERNO restaurant, with music and lottery according to tradition.

Sunday 22/06/2025

Sunday morning is, as always, a time to say goodbye and leave, but we hope to be able to spend some time with friends who are staying until midday.

After breakfast at the hotel, we drive to the medieval village of SERRAVALLE di VITTORIO VENETO **at around 10 a.m.**, where we look for a parking space near the characteristic PIAZZA FLAMINO:

The route described above takes us to the various areas where we can find parking: in Via Guido Casoni, Piazza del Campanile, Via Martiri della Libertà and Piazza Tiziano Vecellio.

Unlike the castle of Conegliano, which dominates the plain from the top of a hill, the ancient castle of Serravalle was built at the narrowest point of the Meschio Valley and, together with two fortresses on the slopes of the nearby hills, controlled access to the Venetian plain for those coming from the mountains to the north. Here too, the connection with the Republic of Venice after 1337 enabled the development of the village of Serravalle with the wealth of its noble palaces adorned with frescoes and decorations in the Venetian style. The COMMUNITY PALACE OF SERRAVALLE and the CITY CLOCK TOWER stand out in Piazza Flamino.

A stroll through the small village allows us to say goodbye with a toast or have lunch in complete freedom before heading home, **as the toll booths for the Vittorio Veneto Nord and Sud highways are only a few minutes away.**
